

Instructions

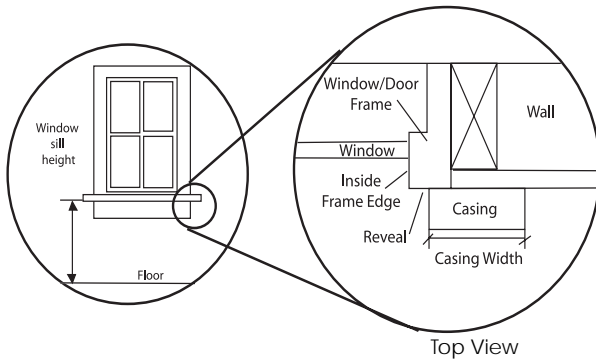
1. Measure your room (to the nearest 1/4"), include:

- Wall lengths
- Door locations (from corners of room)
- Door casing width
- Window location (from corners of room to inside edge of window frame)
- Window sill height (floor to bottom of sill)
- Window height (inside edge top frame to inside edge bottom frame)
- Window casing width
- Window casing to frame reveal

2. Fill out the door and window chart on Page 2

(see example at right) include:

- Door height and width; casing width
- Window width and height; height to bottom of sill; casing width and reveal



Note: Reveal equals distance between inside edge of frame and inside edge of casing.

- Wall lengths
- Door and window locations and corresponding item number from step 2.
